

CORDIER MESTREZAT GRANDS CRUS PRIZE DRAW RULES

Cordier Mestrezat Grands Crus, having its registered office
at the following address: 109 Rue Achard, BP 154, 33 042 Bordeaux Bacalan,
referred to hereafter as “the organiser”,
is organising an advertising operation in the form of a prize draw to be held
from 1st January 2009 to 30 November 2009 on its website www.bordeauxmedailles.com,
on the terms presented below:

Article 1: Terms of the Prize Draw

The game described in the present rules is open to all capable, physical persons of legal age, to the exclusion of all staff of the organising company and their families. The following are also prohibited from taking part in the prize draw: staff and families of staff of commercial partners or companies taking part in any way whatsoever in the organisation and publication of the present prize draw, or in the activity of the organising company in general. Participants must also comply with the terms specific to the prize draw as presented below.

Participation on plain paper or in any form other than by return e-mail to: contact@cordier-wines.com is not possible. The organiser reserves the right to take legal proceedings against any person having cheated, committed fraud, rigged or disrupted the operations described in the present rules. The same applies to any attempts to do the above. During the prize draw operations, as well as the possibility to consult the present rules, a hard copy of the present rules may be sent free of charge to any person who makes a request to that effect to our bailiff Maître Dubois.

By taking part in the prize draw, participants accept the present rules fully and entirely.

The organising company may not be held responsible for any malfunction of telephone services or for any consequences for the present prize draw of any event such as, among other things, social or political movements seriously affecting and/or disrupting all or part of French territory. The present prize draw will be cancelled notably in the event of the dissolution or disappearance of the organising company, or of any event beyond the control of the organiser rendering the prize draw described in the present rules impossible or difficult to hold, or in any other case of force majeure. No information about the prize draw, the present rules, their organisation and terms or any other information will be given, by telephone or any other means, to the public or participants, other than the information provided for by law or the present rules. The organiser undertakes, after the present game, to supply the name of the winner within a reasonable period of time to any person making a request to this effect in writing.¹

By the terms of Article 27, Law 78-17 on “IT and Individual Liberties” of 06 January 1978, all participants have the right to access and rectify any nominative information concerning them, and they may exercise such rights by contacting the organiser.

The prize won by the winners may in no case be exchanged or returned. No compensation or consideration may be claimed other than the prize that has been won. Therefore, the prize may not be exchanged or converted into any product marketed or manufactured by the organiser, nor for or into cash. Likewise, prizes in this operation may not be cumulated with other promotions or advantages offered by the organising company. However, the organiser reserves the right to substitute all or part of a prize by another prize of an equivalent value if it should be impossible to provide the prize provided by the present rules. Winners waive any claims for compensation arising from any prejudice or damage caused by acceptance of the said prize. At all events, any prize that cannot be awarded will be lost to the participants and will remain the property of the organiser.

If it should be brought to the knowledge of the organiser that the winner infringed the present rules or cheated in any other way, the said winner may not be awarded a prize and the organiser reserves the right to take legal proceedings against them.

By filling out an entry form and validating it for the purposes of taking part in the abovementioned prize draw, participants automatically accept that the information provided in the entry form may be used notably for commercial purposes, without the organiser being required to obtain further confirmation of the consent of the participant. Winners hereby accept that the organiser is requesting their authorisation to use, in all ways and for all audiences, not only the information supplied in the entry form, but also their photographs and oral or written declarations for the purposes of advertising and public or press relations, for editorial advertising of all kinds and for all the activities of the organising company, using all means of reproduction, duplication, representation, transmission, reception, coding or any other means, without any compensation or consideration of any kind whatsoever.

Article 2: Description of the Prize Draw

This prize draw will offer the possibility for 5 winners to receive the following prize free of charge:

**A wooden case of 6 bottles of medal-winning wines,
representing an overall commercial value of €80 including tax.**

The winners will be designated by a prize draw held on **7 December 2009** by **Maître DUBOIS, Bailiff, 11 Place Pey-Berland, 33000 BORDEAUX, FRANCE**. To be accepted as valid, the entry e-mail must be filled out exhaustively and in all good faith before being validated by the organiser.

The said e-mail will also make clear reference to the Law on IT and Individual Liberties as indicated in the "General Provisions" of the present rules, and the indication that taking part in the present prize draw implies that the name of participants may be used for commercial purposes, as indicated above.

Article 3: Participation

To take part in the prize draw, the following criterion must be fulfilled to validate the entry form: **only complete e-mails will be taken into account (surname, forename, address, e-mail address). Incomplete e-mails or those received after the date limit of 30 November 2009, as well as any entries received on plain paper, will not be accepted.** Only one prize per family. If a winner is drawn several times, the first draw will be valid.

Article 4: Prizes and Winner Information

For any communication with winners, only the contact details provided by them in their e-mail entry will be used. The organising company undertakes to deliver the prize to the winner as quickly as possible. The draw will be held as follows: the e-mails that have been sent will be printed out. A single draw will be held by Maître Dubois **who will designate the winners of the wooden cases of medal-winning wines.**
